



BUS TRANSIT PROVIDES EVERYONE ACCESS TO OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN NEIGHBORHOODS AND ACROSS THE REGION

Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) and South Bend Public Transportation Corporation (Transpo) invite regional and community leaders, riders and residents to get involved in **CONNECT**.

CONNECT is a regional transit study for the existing Transpo and Interurban Trolley bus service areas of South Bend, Mishawaka, Elkhart, and Goshen and will consider a range of transit service fixed-route options for more rural portions of the region. This project will result in a 10-year plan for the future of transit in the region.

CONNECT seeks to build a shared vision & understanding of the importance of transit service, the opportunities and limitations of the current system and the value of a more robust transit system going forward.

CONNECT is important to every community because it will look at alternative ways to balance important but competing priorities, like improving service along existing fixed routes versus adding new service areas and new routes.

Now through December 2022, MACOG & Transpo will inform and engage key stakeholders and the public in a series of stakeholder workshops and meetings for:

- **Setting Bus Transit Priorities**
- **Considering Transit Network Concepts**
- **Commenting on the Transit Network Redesign Draft Plan**
- **Next Steps upon Final Plan Approval by MACOG & Transpo**



Key public engagement meetings will occur in January, April, and September 2022. Given the pandemic, a combination of in-person and virtual meetings will be offered.

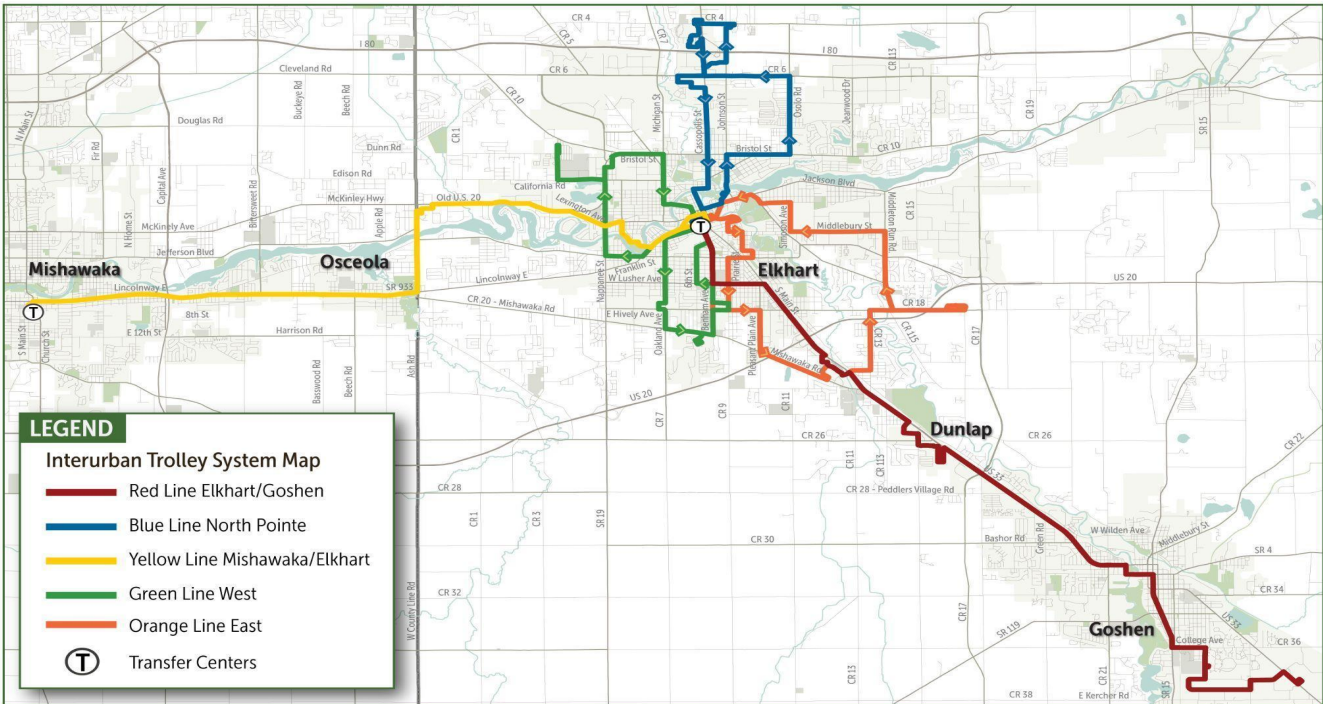
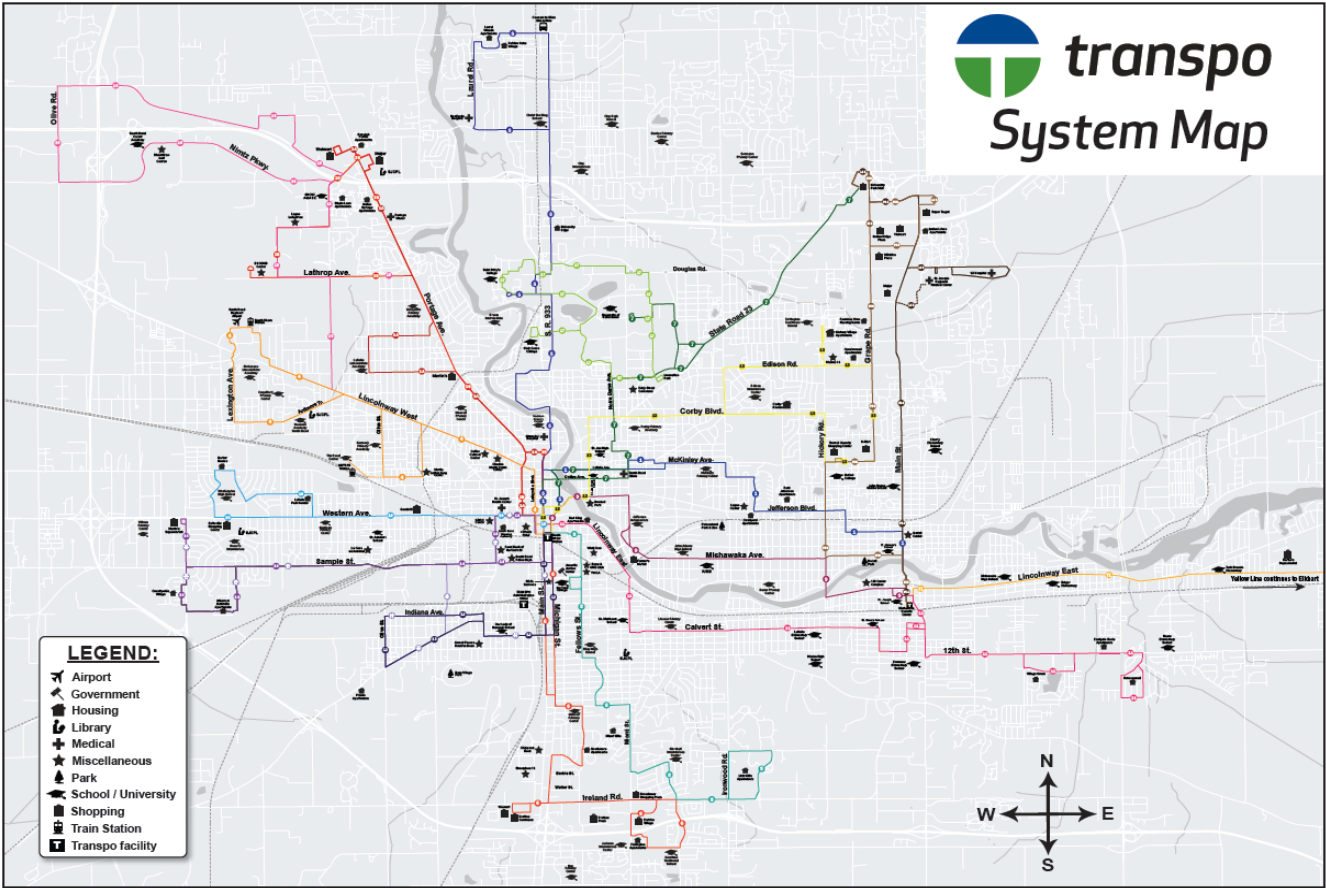
